I. Consent Agenda

The consent agenda consisted of the May financial statements, the May 21, 2023 minutes, the Rector report and the Day School financial report. The consent agenda was approved on a motion by Susan Stevenson, duly seconded, and unanimously approved.

II. Information

A. Johnny Tuttle noted the following:

Johnny may ask that the Bishop visit St. Paul's on January 25, 2024 which is the Feast Day of St. Paul.
